


Gather evidence of the demographic composition of UN Peace Support Operations personnel.

Status:





Female personnel facing more risk (8.3% fatality vs 5.8% proportion 2021-2023)















What demographic mix = more stability?


We have partnered with **Dr Melih Kandemir**, Associate Professor of Machine Learning at the University of Southern Denmark, and founder of the SDU Adaptive Intelligence (ADIN) Lab.

His team is training a Recurrent Neural Network (RNN) to investigate which demographic characteristic variables (diversity indices) are most correlated with stability in different missions (internally and cross-border).
